Goal 1: Live the Catholic and Franciscan tradition of Faith and Reason.

Outcomes:

1. The university's Catholic and Franciscan traditions form the foundation of the university's relationship with stakeholders.
2. The institutional culture fosters spiritual growth, meaning and purpose.
3. The university community demonstrates the Franciscan Value: Reverence the unique dignity of each person.
4. The university community demonstrates the Franciscan Value: Encourage a trustful, prayerful community of learners.
5. The university community demonstrates the Franciscan Value: Serve one another, society and the church.
6. The university community demonstrates the Franciscan Value: Foster peace and justice.
7. The university community demonstrates the Franciscan Value: Respect creation.
8. Graduates of the university live the Franciscan values in their personal and professional lives.
9. Catholic employees and trustees provide for witness of the Catholic faith and those of other faiths acknowledge and respect the university's Catholic identity and mission.
10. Personal services (health care, counseling and guidance) to students and employees are provided in conformity with the Church's ethical and religious teaching and directives.
11. The university provides opportunities for reflection and dialogue regarding Faith and Reason.
12. Research is carried out with concern for ethical and moral implications.
13. The university collaborates with diocesan agencies.
14. The university is faithful to the teachings of the Catholic Church.
